



The Italian Association of Children's Hospitals (AOPI) at the service of pediatric patients from Ukraine

The Italian Association of Children's Hospitals (AOPI) has taken action to help young Ukrainian patients and their families: the association has made itself available to national and international humanitarian organizations to support, through its network, the needs of those involved in the war. The initiative is part of the common humanitarian effort for healthcare aid to the Ukrainian population shared by the G7 Ministries of Health. The most important Italian entities dedicated to caring for children and adolescents are preparing a coordinated plan to accommodate children in need who can reach Italy thanks to the activation of humanitarian channels. In recent days, the President of AOPI, Alberto Zanobini, has been in touch with the hospitals that are part of the European Children's Hospitals Organisation (ECHO), with the objective of understanding how best to support the children's hospitals that find themselves at the front lines of the refugee emergency.
